The Geopuncture installation is coming. This article shows the cosmogrammes for an installation dedicated to the hierarchies placed at Emerson Woods in Kentucky. It gives you a sense of the presence of the cosmogrammes carved in stone.

Marko Pogacnik will arrive September 30 and the project commences on October 1.

We will begin the project by refining the images (cosmogrammes) to be carved onto the stones which will be limestone pillars 5 feet high, 20 inches wide and 9 inches deep. There will be 17 stones.

The installation has two themes: The first relates to the Grail. This story has deep roots harkening back to pre-patriarchial times in Europe. The second relates to a creation myth of the Native peoples called Sky Woman. Each of these stories acknowledges a great spiritual source of life on Earth. In our times we are learning that this source, this fount of life cannot be dismissed or excluded from our human deeds without paying a terrible price. The powerful communications of the elements in our time remind us that we have neglected this world of the elements and elementals. The installation reminds, awakens, strengthens and connects us with this dimension of reality out of which life emerges. It is a deed of communication and healing of our relationship to the living Earth.

There are various ways to participate in this project.

The carving will take place outdoors under tents on the field near the woodwork room of the Toronto Waldorf School. We will be working daily on the carving. The schedule is not fixed as it is tied to the needs of the work as it arises. You are invited to drop by and visit. There will be hosts available to speak with you about the project and explain the work.

We will host evening lecture/conversations led by Marko that all are welcome to join. We ask for a \$10 donation to join these conversations. The schedule and location of these conversations will be available closer to the dates of the project.
