

Dress Code Policy

The Foxborough Regional Charter School Board of Trustees believes that part of an orderly learning environment is the appropriate appearance of the students attending school. Such appearance should reflect positively on the school and be consistent with standards of decency so that one's attire does not distract students or staff from creating and maintaining a proper learning environment. To that end the Board embraces a dress code that shall be enforced by staff. The administration will also develop expectations for physical education classes, for non-dress code days, and any other school related activities, as needed. The dress code shall consist of the following criteria:

Dress Code Expectations—Dress code will be strictly enforced. All instances of interpretation cannot be effectively covered in one document. Administration reserves the right to interpret individual's clothing as it pertains to the dress code policy.

- All students are expected and required to dress in a respectful, professional manner.
- All items of clothing must be professional fitting; not too loose nor tight.
- Jeans, yoga pants, leggings, jeggings, tight pants, gym attire, cargo shorts/pants, etc. are not professional attire. Students may change for gym classes in the locker rooms.
- Shorts, skorts, and skirts cannot be any higher than 2 inches from the knee.
- No outerwear or accessories, such as scarves, are allowed during the school day.
- Hats are not allowed to be worn in the building at any time.
- Religious head coverings are allowed and need to be solid navy blue, tan, or white.
- Piercings are limited to ears only.
- No hair color that is unnatural will be allowed (for example, blue or green).
- Tights or knee high socks which are worn with skirts, jumpers, skorts, or shorts need to be solid navy blue, tan, or white. Regular nylons/pantyhose are allowed.

Boys Dress Code

- solid navy blue or tan dress pants or shorts
- solid navy blue, white, or tan school logo polo shirt or oxford
- solid navy blue, white, or tan school logo sweater or sweatshirt
- t-shirts and turtlenecks may be worn under the school logo shirt, sweatshirt, or sweater but the t-shirt or turtleneck needs to be solid navy blue, tan, or white

Girls Dress Code

- solid navy blue or tan dress pants
- solid navy blue or tan school logo jumper (no higher than 2 inches from the knee)
- solid navy blue or tan skirt (no higher than 2 inches from the knee)
- solid navy blue or tan shorts (no higher than 2 inches from the knee)
- solid navy blue, white, or tan school logo polo shirt, oxford, or collared blouse
- solid navy blue, white, or tan school logo sweater or sweatshirt
- t-shirts and turtlenecks may be worn under the school logo shirt, sweatshirt, or sweater but the t-shirt or turtleneck needs to be solid navy blue, tan, or white

Shoes

- Sneakers
- Enclosed shoes or boots (covering toes and heels)
- Pants need to cover the top of boots and only the foot of the boot can be showing
