# Ski Trip Helpful Hints

- Please don't forget to dress appropriately for mountain weather. Waterproof pants, jacket, and gloves are recommended. Also, don't forget to dress in layers and wear a hat and/or scarf. It is also recommended that you bring along an extra pair of socks to wear on the bus ride home. Dressing in layers is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!
- While Mountain High offers equipment rentals, there is typically a long wait to receive your equipment at the rental counter. If you would like to alleviate this wait, there are several options for renting locally. See below for options.
- While the cold weather often makes us think we don't need sun protection, the snow actually magnifies the sun's rays. Sunglasses/goggles and sunscreen are encouraged.
- Lockers are available on the mountain. Bring quarters if you plan on renting a locker.
- Don't forget to plan a lunch. You can bring a packed sack lunch or purchase from several options on the mountain.
- Please make sure EVERYTHING you bring is labeled. Also, please be mindful of what you bring to the mountain. It is not a good idea to bring expensive equipment to the mountain. The resort is open to the general public who may be looking to walk away with items left lying around the chalet!


