MBA Research Project (Thesis)

This essential component of the MBA programme is the four-month individual research project in which student will apply the knowledge, skills, methods and theory gained on the taught MBA modules. The research project is the most rewarding and challenging part of the two year MBA journey of learning and improving skills. It involves a much focused investigation on the area of your interest within the business industry. We prefer researchers to identify a real management problem and seek the right and best solution to the problem so that organisation can take benefit from the research. The students have to write the 20,000 words thesis. If you are sponsored by your organisation, you would investigate management problem in your workplace, otherwise your supervisor will recommend some organisations and their problems to consider for your research project. The research projects improves your research skills and deepen your knowledge to solve the real management problems.

We are approaching many private and public organisations for your research projects.

The project will be agreed between student and main supervisor and will be undertaken at place of work.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum Second Class Undergraduate (Bachelor's) degree from University or College accredited by the country of origin
- A Secure English Language Test (SELT) certificate, from a UK Border Agency approved provider, showing that student has achieved level B2 on the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR)
- Minimum Age 21
