The Summer Surgery Program is an in-depth interactive course designed to foster the interest of high school students toward a career in medicine. This two-week program introduces students, or Summer Surgeons, to generalized surgical practice through live case observation in the operating room; hands-on laboratory workshops in open, laparoscopic, and robotic surgery; and lectures by distinguished UC Irvine faculty. Given the intimacy of the program and the nature of the instruction, tuition is \$3,950 per student, and \$5,250 with room and board.* Applications are accepted on a rolling basis through May 10th.

We are now only accepting applicants for Sessions II and III. Spots are extremely limited. The dates are as follows:

- Session I: June 17th 28th
- Session II: July 1st 12th
- Session III: July 15th 26th *

To apply for UC Irvine's Summer Surgery Program, students must be at least 16 years old, have a minimum GPA of 3.5, and be currently enrolled in high school (2013 senior graduates welcome). Four need-based scholarships per session are available for eligible students. *Room and board is available for out-of-town and international students only for Session III.
