DERECH ERETZ; KADIMA BEHAVIOR POLICY

DERECH ERETZ IS DEFINED BY YOUR IMPACT ON OTHERS DERECH ERETZ IN EVERY-DAY LIFE GOVERNS WHAT TO DO DERECH ERETZ IN EVERY-DAY LIFE GOVERNS WHAT NOT TO DO

Derech Eretz is the Hebrew phrase for personal actions of mutual respect; decent, polite, respectful, thoughtful, and civilized behavior. Behavior in our program is governed by Jewish values, which emphasize treating everyone involved in the educational experience (students, teachers, parents and school leadership) with *Derech Eretz*.

It is the student's right to learn and the teacher's right to teach. No one has the right to interfere with the teaching-learning process.

Kadima will attempt to accommodate, to the best of its staff's abilities, a student's learning disabilities; however, Kadima does not have any special education or therapeutic support and therefore, cannot accommodate serious behavior/social disruptions in the classroom. In the rare instance requiring disciplinary action, Kadima's discipline plan is as follows:

If a minor problem arises, teachers will handle it directly within the classroom. Teachers will make every effort to deal with disciplinary problems in a positive, productive, and age appropriate manner within the classroom. The teacher will advise the student that their behavior is unacceptable and may not be repeated. In the case of electronic devices, they will be taken away for the remainder of the class, and will be retrieved at the end of the day by the parent/s.

Occasionally, however, such efforts may prove ineffective and it will be necessary to take formal action by bringing the behavior to the attention of the Education Director.

- I. First serious behavior disruption—which interferes with the learning opportunity of classmates and others—will result in a first warning. The process is as follows:
 - 1. The student will be asked to fill out a Behavior Report, stating what happened and what could have been done to prevent it. The student will also speak with the Education Director and the teacher at that time.
 - 2. Student, teacher, and Education Director develop a change of behavior contract that the Education Director sends (or gives) to the family, and to the teacher.
 - 3. The Director of Education, together with the teacher, will establish an improvement plan.
- II. The Second serious behavior disruption which interferes with the learning opportunity of classmates and others —will result in a final warning.
 - 1. In addition to the above steps, the parent/s will be brought into the conversation.
 - 2. Education Director will contact parent/s to discuss the situation and seek their assistance. The Education Director and the teacher will discuss the behavior with the parent/s and develop a plan of action that may include the parent/s attending classes with their student.
- III. Third serious behavior disruption— which interferes with the learning opportunity of classmates and others will result in expulsion.
 - 1. Teacher will notify the Education Director at the time of the disruption.
 - 2. Student will be asked to leave the classroom for a conference with the Education Director.
 - 3. Teacher gives Education Director a written report of student's behavior, which will be sent to the parents.
 - 4. Education Director notifies parents that student is expelled from school.

PLEASE NOTE: If student's behavior results in expulsion, tuition refund will follow the liability schedule as if the student withdrew.

IV. ABUSIVE OR VIOLENT BEHAVIOR IS NOT ALLOWED AT ANY KADIMA EVENT AND WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION.

KADIMA MEMBERSHIP CONTRACT 2012-2013

MEMBER INVOLVEMENT EXPECTATIONS

I/We understand that Kadima relies heavily upon member involvement, and that in the absence of such involvement, Kadima cannot fully carry out its mission and programming. I/We agree that our household will contribute at least 20 hours per adult in our household during the year. **ALL MEMBERS ARE ASKED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM.**

TUITION REFUND POLICY AND SCHEDULE

If a student withdraws from Kadima prior to October 7, 2012, the family will only be responsible for payment of the tuition deposit of \$100. Membership is non-refundable.

Because staffing is based on the number of students enrolled in classes, families who withdraw their students from Kadima after October 7, 2012, will be responsible for payment of tuition on a prorated basis. The balance due to Kadima will be calculated as a percentage of total tuition, including deposits, but excluding registration fees, as follows:

Withdrawal 10/7/12 - 11/18/12 25% of total fees will be due Withdrawal 11/19/12 - 12/16/12 50% of total fees will be due Withdrawal 12/17/12 - 1/13/13 75% of total fees will be due Withdrawal 1/14/13 - 6/30/13 Family is responsible for paying all tuition

PENALTIES FOR LATE PAYMENT

I/We will pay a \$35.00 charge for all checks returned by the bank for nonpayment. If payment needs to be deferred due to family financial changes, I/we agree to discuss this with the Kadima office on or before the date payment is due, and all late charges and interest may be waived. Any fees outstanding from the previous year must be paid prior to the start of the new school year.

PERMISSION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE

I/We give permission for my/our child(ren) to receive basic first aid while at Kadima. I/We consent to emergency medical, surgical, and hospital treatment by a licensed medical emergency team, physician, or hospital (including transport by aid car or ambulance) when deemed immediately necessary to guard my/our child(ren)'s health while at Kadima, and I/we cannot be contacted. I/We waive my/our right to informed consent for such treatment.

PERMISSION FOR FIELD TRIPS

I/We give permission for my/our child(ren) to attend Kadima field trips, and understand that transport will be by parent carpool, public transit, or walking. Parents will be notified of any field trips in advance. Teachers are required to notify the Education Director if they are taking students off the grounds of the Kadima House/Seattle Jewish Community School.
