- The implications of the Fairfax County Strategic Facilities Plan for McLean families and how the County and School Board can work together to resolve some of the issues that have been raised; and
- Proposals for an independent audit capability for the School Board, to mirror the Supervisors' Audit Committee and Office of Financial and Program Audit.

Opening remarks by Cluster I Assistant Superintendent Marty Smith, School Board member Jane Strauss, and Supervisor John Foust will be followed by an extended question and answer period during which you will have the opportunity to ask **your** questions.
