## In order to receive this service, the child must...

• Be a MediCal recipient; and

- Be at risk for removal from a child care or preschool placement due to behavioral, social or emotional problems; and
- Show significant social, emotional or behavioral problems at home or in the community and
- Must live in Western Riverside County (i.e., cities of Corona, Norco, Mira Loma, Moreno Valley, Riverside, Rubidoux, or Jurupa)

## Services provided to qualified families:

- Behavior modification programs provided in the child's home.
- Consultation with the child's preschool staff.
- Consultation with the child's pediatrician or other healthcare provider.
- Assistance in making a smooth transition to kindergarten.
