## What is CSA?

CSA, or Community Supported Agriculture is a partnership of mutual commitment between a farm and a community of supporters. CSA members make a commitment to join the farm, assuming the risks and bounty of growing the food along with the farmer. The farm provides a "CSA share", a healthy supply of fresh, seasonal produce. CSA builds connections to the land and to community.
