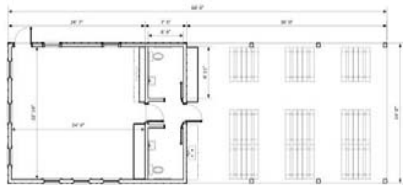


TIMELINE

- ◆ In the summer of 2011 the previous shelter at City Park was discovered to be unsafe and needed to be torn down
- ◆ In the fall of 2011 the City of Philomath conducted a survey to find out what our citizens want in its place
- ◆ The plans and renderings in this brochure reflect those responses
- ◆ Steve Oien Construction has been hired to build the foundation
- ◆ The structure will be put out to bid once the foundation is complete
- ◆ **TOTAL PROJECT COST ESTIMATE:**
 - ◆ ~\$80,000
 - ◆ \$32,000 Raised to Date
 - ◆ Funds needed to complete- ~\$50,000

BUILD A SHELTER IN CITY PARK

The Shelter will be rebuilt with indoor and outdoor meeting space.

The interior will be furnished with a sink and cabinets to accommodate small groups with onsite storage needs. Anticipated seating capacity is 40.

The outdoor space will have ample room for a summer BBQ, with covered seating for 54.



HOW TO GET INVOLVED

The easiest way to get involved is to simply "buy" a brick that will be included in the walkway around the Shelter. The bricks can be engraved with your name, or any other message you'd like. 4 x 8 bricks can have 2 lines of up to 14 characters per line. 8 x 8 bricks can have up to 3 lines.

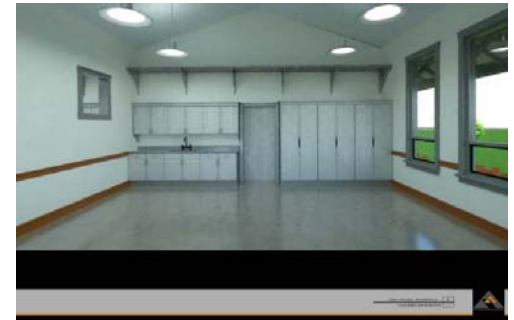
