If you haven't been to downtown Excelsior Springs recently, you haven't been to Downtown Excelsior Springs! After lunch Wednesday, take a guided tour of downtown and see how things are evolving and changing. The tour will start at the Hall of Waters, one of several National Register properties in downtown, and will then move to the new housing development, The Villas, which is a mixture of new homes and historic renovation adding over 40 new families to downtown. The tour will stop at various buildings that have either recently been restored or are being developed by the owner or the Downtown Excelsior Partnership and will end at The Elms Hotel and Spa, which just completed a multi-million dollar renovation and restoration that included the exterior and interior with a complete reworking of the spa area.
