The Department of Justice's new 2010 ADA Standards, effective March 15, 2012, addresses access to recreation facilities. The guidelines include technical provisions for providing access to play areas, fishing piers, recreational boating facilities, swimming pools, wading pools and spas. These types of facilities were not addressed in the 1991 Standard, and as such are not covered by the Safe Harbor provision of the 2010 ADA Standards. New construction and alteration to these types of recreational facilities must comply with the 2010 ADA Standards.

DCAB will be hosting a two-day series of seminars presented by Mr. Bill Botten of the U.S. Access Board, that will cover recreation facilities and their supporting areas and amenities. In addition, one of the sessions will also review the upcoming Outdoor Developed Areas Accessibility Guidelines, discussing the proposed scoping and technical provisions for accessible trails, camping areas, picnic areas and beach access.
