ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY

This matter is before this Court pursuant to Appellant International Chiropractors Association's motion for stay filed with this Court. Appellant International Chiropractors Association seeks an order to stay Appellee New Mexico Board of Chiropractic Examiners regarding the following:

- (1) implementing a certain portion its new 2011 rules and regulations establishing an advanced practice chiropractic formulary to include dangerous drugs and drugs to be administered by injection under 16.4.15.11 NMAC, and
- (2) implementing a certain portion of its new rules and regulations establishing certain additional educational requirements and course of training to allow advanced

practice chiropractic physicians to administer and prescribe dangerous drugs and drugs to be administered by injection under 16.4.15.12 NMAC.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion seeking a stay regarding the implementation of these specific new 2011 rules and regulations is HEREBY GRANTED. This Court further determines that this ruling and order does not affect the continued application and use of the formulary under the 2010 rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners. If, during the pendency of the appeal a resolution or partial resolution is reached by the parties, this Court invites any of the parties to file a separate motion to lift the stay, in whole or in part.
