RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS

One of the most difficult decisions a parent of a child with special needs has to make is when to place their son or daughter in a residential program. All of us would like to take care of our children (including our adult children) forever. We are their parents and nobody can take care of them better than us. Many of us have prayed that we outlive our children with disabilities, since we fear what would happen to them when we are no longer alive. We dread even thinking about how our sons and daughters would live in a group home without their mothers and fathers to tend to their every need. Many of us have heard or read horror stories about incidents that often happen in residential facilities. That is another reason many of us do not look forward to the time when we must face the inevitable group home placement. Well, this month we decided to tackle this issue with as much information and resources as we could muster. Our Special Children has invited a very knowledgeable expert from MHMR of Tarrant, Ms. Ashley Perry, Director of Intake/Access, to come to our meeting and discuss all of the issues concerning residential programs. She will explain the difference between HCS and ICF/MR homes, talk about qualifications and waiting lists, address what rights we have as parents and clients, and share ideas and suggestions on how to best handle the transition from family home to group home. We have also invited several representatives from provider agencies to attend the meeting, so we can hear explanations and information from the people who actually manage many of the residential programs in our area. You will hear from three executive directors from Educare, one of the leading ICF/MR providers in North Texas. You will also have the opportunity to meet directors from Daybreak, Champion Services, and Southern Concepts. These three providers manage HCS group homes in Tarrant County and surrounding counties. They will provide us with an insight as to how group homes are managed, how their staff is trained and monitored, how parents can interact with their organization both before selecting them and after their child is living in their residences, and any other helpful advice for families thinking about or considering future residential placement. The meeting will also benefit from the perspective of parents who have adult children living in group homes. Ms. Sharon Sanderson, Arc of GTC board member, and Ms. Valerie Eckert will share their experiences dealing with residential providers. It is always helpful to hear from other parents who have paved the way for the rest of us. Do not miss this opportunity to find out as much as you can about residential programs.

Lose the Training Wheels (LTTW) teaches individuals with differing abilities how to ride conventional two-wheel bicycles—without training wheels! Approximately 80% of LTTW participants can successfully balance on a two-wheel bike by the end of the weeklong training camp. The Down Syndrome Partnership of Tarrant County is hosting its third LTTW camp from July 30 to August 3, 2012 with a parent meeting and volunteer training on July 29, on the campus of the University of Texas at Arlington. 140 volunteers (28 volunteers per 75-minute session) are needed to spot the participants as they learn how to ride (must be at least 16 years old); additional volunteers are needed to help with other duties.
