D-Day: The Invasion of Normandy

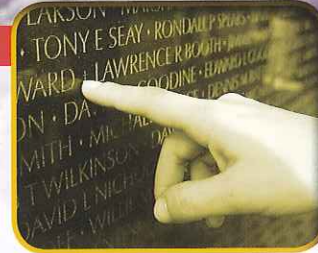

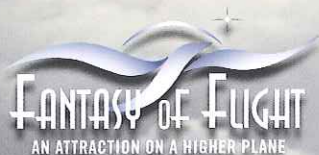
