Produce boxes filled with a variety of local fruits and vegetables from Tanaka Farms will be delivered weekly (on Thursdays) to the Journey School campus. Pick up your box and enjoy not only delicious food but also helping your school. Tanaka Farms will donate a portion of each purchase back to Journey!

Benefits of this program:

- Enjoy local, organically grown produce and try new foods.
- Sign up online and manage your account online.
- Instead of a large up-front payment, pay for just one box at a time.
- You have control over your deliveries (choose every week or every other week).
- Set “vacation” times if you won’t be able to get your box one week.
- Choose your box size and change it at any time.
- Journey School receives 10% back!

How it works:

Go online to www.tanakafarms.com/CSA.html.

Click on the green NEW SUBSCRIBERS button on the right-hand side.

Choose your location: Journey School.

Fill out all other information and submit.

Deliveries will begin November 8th and will coincide with the school calendar (no boxes on school holidays).

LARGE BOX: \$33

contains 9-11 different items, including
5-7 types of vegetables and 3-4 types of fruit

SMALL BOX: \$23

contains 6-8 different items, varying
according to the season

Sample boxes will be available to view at the Harvest Faire

Please note: if boxes are not picked up within 24 hours, they will be donated to Journey School to be used for the children.
