Be faithful in prayer. Share with God's people. Be hospitable.</p> <p>Bless those who persecute you. Do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice. Mourn with those who mourn. Live in harmony with others. Be humble enough to associate with people of low position.</p> <p>Do not repay evil for evil. Do what is right. Live at peace with everybody. Do not take revenge. Remember that God will avenge. Feed your enemy, be kind to him so he might repent. Do not be overcome by evil. Overcome evil with good.</p> <p>Submit to the authorities. Pay your taxes. Give everyone what you owe them. Continue to love one another. Love your neighbor as yourself. Clothe yourself with the Lord. Do not think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature.</p>
