When **Noemy** was a little girl growing up in Costa Rica, she often thought about being a missionary and working with children. In 1995, when *Hogar de Vida* opened in her hometown of Atenas, she quickly made inquiries about working there.

Hired first as a *tia* (on staff), Noemy worked under the direction of Olga, the housemother, learning the many aspects of running a children's home.

In 1999, Noemy answered God's call to Guatemala to assume the position of director of Home of Life and Nutrition. Over the next nine years, Noemy raised up and released into leadership the current home directors.

She and her adopted daughter, Ana, returned to Costa Rica in 2008 where she now serves as housemother for the third children's home at *Hogar de Vida*.

Noemy wants to live as a faith missionary to reduce the financial burden on the mission.
