

JULY IS CALIFORNIA'S WATER SMART MONTH

The City wants to help residents and businesses use water wisely.

Traditionally the peak outdoor water-use month throughout the State of California, Governor Brown deemed July 2013 as "Water Smart Month" throughout California. Reservoirs draw down from heavy use in the summer and won't begin to fill until the rain and snow (hopefully) arrive later in the year. American Canyon relies on the State Water Project for its water supply, with supplemental water from neighboring the city's use.

The City offers several programs to assist residents and businesses in saving water – and money! These programs are supported by the City of American Canyon and Prop 84 Grant from the Department of Water Resources. Applications can be picked up at City Hall, 4381 Broadway, across from Walmart) in the Environmental Education Brochure rack in the lobby.

The highest outside water use –
Cash for Grass Rebate

(Single-Family Residential Homes: maximum of \$750/750 square feet, Commercial/Multifamily Property: \$2,500/ 2,500 square feet)

Note: Turf area to be replaced must currently be irrigated, maintained and healthy to qualify for the rebate. Although the City appreciates the waterwise homeowners who have already replaced their water-thirsty turf, the program cannot accommodate applications for retroactive rebates.

The highest indoor water use –
Toilet Retrofit Rebate

\$100 for each toilet that flushes greater than 1.6 gallons per flush and free recycling of the old toilet porcelain

The second highest indoor water use
– Clothes Washer Rebate

For purchases beginning January 1, 2013, the highest efficiency washers (CEE Tier 3) qualify for a **\$100 rebate** comprised of \$50 from PG&E and \$50 from the City of American Canyon. The City portion is supported by a Prop 84 Grant from the California Department of Water Resources.
