

Senior Clipper Cards

are now available in the Tri-City Area!



Clipper is an all-in-one transit card that keeps track of multiple transit passes, ride books or tickets, and any cash value that you load onto it, while applying all applicable fares, discounts and transfer rules. The Senior Clipper Card will automatically calculate the discounted cash fare, monthly pass fare or transfer fare each time you use Clipper on transit.

The Senior Clipper Card can be used to pay for fares on: AC Transit, BART, SF Muni, Caltrain, SamTrans, Santa Clara Valley Transit, Golden Gate Ferries and Buses and the San Francisco Bay Ferry.

Seniors (65 years and older) are eligible to apply for a Clipper Card at:

Senior Clipper Card applications are available at the above locations. You must complete an application and provide one of the following forms of identification to verify your eligibility:

Birth Certificate, Passport, Driver's License, State-issued Identification Card, Alien Registration/Permanent Resident Card, Matricula Consular ID Card, San Francisco City Identification Card, Military ID Card w/ date of birth, Medical Benefit Card w/ date of birth.

There is no cost to get the card. Senior Clipper cards are issued immediately.

Cards have no value and must be loaded with value prior to using the card on transit.

Cards may be loaded with value at any BART Station and at select retail locations.
