Supports salaries for the music director, pianist, and office manager. Raises funds for the Northern Virginia AIDS Ministry. Takes communion together. Keeps wafers and wine in store. ON-LINE BILL PAY

TRADITIONAL GIVING

You know about this one. You just write a check, or place cash in a giving envelope, and place it in the offering basket.

NON-CASH ASSETS

If you have items of value that you wish to donate, that can be done as well. These can be items that MCC NOVA can use in its activities (office supplies, etc.) or they can be more valuable items that MCC NOVA can then sell to raise money. Check with us to make sure we can use your gift, and if so, MCC NOVA will give you a receipt stating that you've given an item of value. You can then designate a value for the item (which must be supportable) and deduct it on your taxes as a charitable gift.
