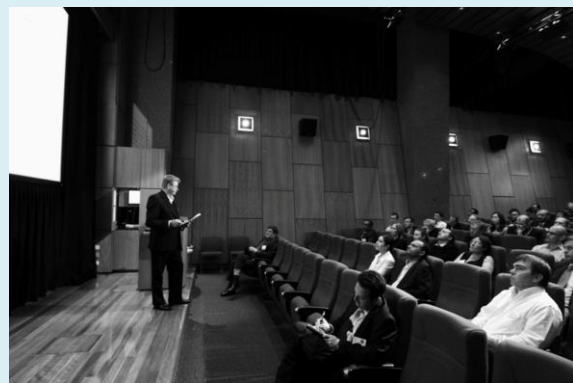

A Survey of Project Management Professionals about Project Governance

University of Technology Sydney (UTS) and its research partners are conducting an Australian Research Council funded study to investigate the antecedents of project blow outs across a range of industries and project governance mechanisms. The survey will focus specifically on theory related questions from organization studies literature to draw theoretical insights on governance mechanisms to help manage project blowouts.

As part of the study we are surveying Project Management Professionals to distinguish between the various aspects of project governance to allow analysis at a level of detail that has not previously been examined. The survey investigates project governance mechanisms occurring at both the organizational level and at the project level. The questions for the survey are based on four prominent organizational theories that deal with governance and improvisation and recently published literature on project performance.

The data from the survey will be analysed using the SmartPLS software <http://www.smartpls.de/forum/> which has the functionality to use formative and reflective measurement scales to estimate finite mixture models, interaction effects and second-order measurement models to understand the array of governance structures and control mechanisms that are applied to a project and how these structures and mechanisms can affect project performance.

Based on the results of the survey, we will develop a theoretical framework that distinguishes those governance and sense-making practices that are, contingently, empirically important for managing project blow-outs. The results from the survey will be presented to members of PMI in Australia.
