New miners are required to have a minimum of 40 hours of training plus pass a written exam and drug screen prior to starting work as an inexperienced miner.

- *Self-rescue and respiratory devices*
- *Entering and leaving the mine*
- *Transportation and communications*
- *Introduction to the work environment*
- *Mine map; escape-ways; emergency evacuation and barricading*
- *Roof or ground control and ventilation plans*
- *Health*
- *Cleanup and rock dusting*
- *Hazard recognition*
- *Electrical hazards*
- *First aid*
- *Mine gases*
- *Health and safety aspects of the tasks to which the new miner will be assigned*
- *Other topics as may be required by the District Manager based on circumstances and conditions at the mine*
