Some highlights:

All five PWDs went clean in both rounds the first day!

- Brisa and Jack both went 4/4 in the preliminary rounds. Brisa earned the breed medallion as the fastest of the clean dogs. Brisa missed going to the finals by only one spot. A real achievement.
- The competition was tighter than ever this year. All finalists were perfect in all rounds, so it came down to speed. In past years, some dogs have made it to the finals with 395/400 points.
- Jack earned honors as the highest ranked PWD for yet another year! This award is based on cumulative speed points and double Q bonuses throughout the year. He has earned this award multiple years.
- Fisher was the fastest of the PWDs. At the end of the first day, they give out group awards. Fisher earned a cash prize as the second place dog in the Working group.
- Also impressive was that all 5 PWDs placed in the top 11 of the Working group. (Brisa was 3, Lucy was 6, Pepin was 7 and Jack was 11.) That is something for the PWDs to be proud of! Fisher was clean in 2/4 runs
- Pepin was clean for 3/4 rounds, only dropping a bar in the last round. A real heartbreaker. This was Sandy's first trip to the Invitational and she did a fabulous job.
