

ENTRY FORM

We are very glad to have you participating in this year's Film Festival! We especially hope that this year's installment will be a great opportunity to showcase the talents and creativity God has given you. Here are the guidelines that must be followed for your entry to be accepted and shown at the event. If you have any other questions about your film or its eligibility, please write to <a href="Market Name of Name of

- Illegal (government laws or LeTourneau policies) or immoral activities (specifically, but not limited to; drinking, smoking, or sexually suggestive images) should not be condoned.
 Use extreme caution if depicting activities of this nature, and ask YAC before you proceed, rather than after you have finished your film.
- Your film must not be dishonoring to Christ. While it need not overtly communicate Christian values, your film should contain no content which would receive a PG-13 or higher rating.
- One member of the film's production team needs to serve as a contact person to YAC.
- All entries will be submitted with the understanding that entries are available for further use as YAC sees fit or for further university purposes.
- Judges will make their decision based on: Picture, Acting, Screenplay and Film Editing.
 A prize will also be given to the audience favorite, which will be determined by the
 attendees of the film awards showing.
- Total time limit of entry (intro/credits included) should not extend beyond: <u>10 minutes</u>.
- The only formats that will be accepted are .AVI, or .WMV. No other formats will be accepted. All other formats will be rejected. You may burn it as a data file TO a DVD, but DO NOT burn it AS a DVD. (There should only be ONE file turned in)
- This entry form must be turned into the YAC office with the film by 5:00 pm on MONDAY, <u>November 14th</u>. YAC will not accept any films without an accompanying signed entry form.

(YAC reserves the right to refuse the showing of any film submitted for any reason)

More important details: A panel of anonymous judges will review each film. Based on their recommendations, the films will be selected for viewing as part of the festival. These judges will also make their choices as to which films should receive the various awards. Filmmakers, cast, and crew should plan on attending the formal film showing and red carpet awards ceremony on **November 18, 2011** in the LeTourneau University Belcher Center.
