Thanks for your patience and feedback as we switched TV providers from Longview Cable to an internal LETU TV system at the end of last semester. New Digital Channel Lineup Coming Soon

The current interim LETU TV system, like the old Longview Cable system, is an analog TV system, currently featuring 23 Channels. During the past semester we have also been working on the final phase of the project, a brand new digital TV system. The new system will feature over 80 channels, will include a number of channels in HD including the major broadcast networks, and the opportunity to bring you LETU programming on our own LETU channels.

What you Need

In order to take advantage of this new system, you will need a digital TV (current flat-panel TVs should all be compatible). If you do not have a digital TV, we will offer a reduced lineup on older analog equipment this semester during the transition to help those who still have older TVs.

Timeframe

We know anticipation for the new system is high and we apologize for the delay in switching to it. Currently we expect to receive shipment of the new equipment and begin installing it this week, after which another week or two may be required to configure the system. We will keep you updated via the Communicator and communication to the RDs and RAs as timelines become firm.
