Program Highlights 2013-14

- * We currently have over 60 incoming Interns (MFTT, MFTI, PCCI, ASW, MSW and BSW), which is the equivalent of at least 35 full time employees
- * Interns are placed at approximately 50 schools throughout the district
- * 47 interns are coming from 13 different Universities
- * 23 of the interns are either MFTIs or ASWs (post master's interns)
- * Approximately 38 SFUSD employees will be providing some level of onsite supervision to interns
- * Student Intervention Team is now a certified Continuing Education Provider
- * All 5 Clinical Supervisors have returned for this school year
