Responsive Education for All Learners (REAL)

Students with diverse learning needs (Special Education or 504 eligible students with disabilities, English language learners, students with diverse temperaments, social emotional characteristics and other variables) require careful planning of lessons to allow these students to progress in core curriculum and to demonstrate standards mastery. This institute is composed of two days of initial training and skill practice, followed by a one day follow up to both showcase the on-site implementation of procedures to support these students and to receive additional training material.

Learning objectives for REAL Institute:

- Learn methods of teaching all students that result in adaptations for the diverse learner
Learn the three areas of research on instructional strategies that highlight why this method produces enhanced outcomes for all learners
Learn and develop skill fluency with an individualized adaptation/accommodation plan that is a procedure that documents the collaborative effort of the school community: general educators, special educators or ELL staff.
