Are you eligible for *Aid and Attendance* Benefits?

What is *Aid and Attendance*?

Aid and Attendance is a special monthly pension benefit available to certain veterans and their surviving spouses which can be used to help supplement the cost of assisted living.

Veterans who served 90 days or more on active duty with at least one day in wartime and were honorably discharged may be eligible for a substantial monthly benefit.
