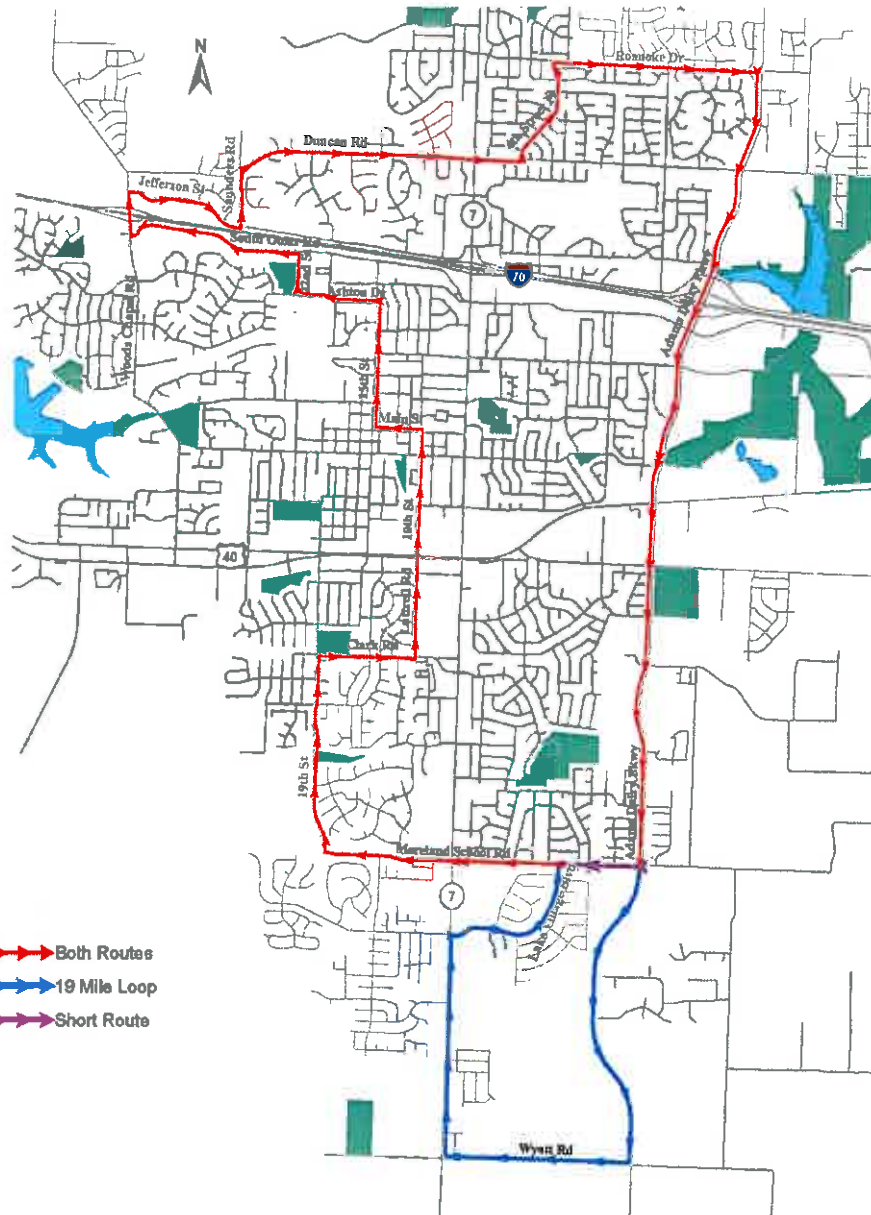

BLUE SPRINGS NIGHT RIDE

Saturday, June 9, 11:30 p.m. Start

Cyclists join us for the Blue Springs Night Ride, an entertaining late night bicycle ride through the streets of Blue Springs. Experienced cyclists of all ages are welcome. The event is not timed - ride at your own pace. Rain date is June 16. Call 816-228-0116 for cancellation information.

Distance

Cyclists can choose between the 14 mile route and the 19 mile route. The roads will be clearly marked, but not blocked off. Participants will cycle on the streets along with the regular vehicular traffic. Police officials will monitor the busy intersections with volunteers at most of the turn points.

The Route

Your evening will start at 11:30 p.m. at the Centennial Pool-Plex, 2401 NW Ashton Drive. Journey West on the Outer Road to Woods Chapel Road, across I-70 to the North side of town. Head South on Adams Dairy Parkway (14 milers cutoff at Moreland School Road), 19 milers cutoff on Wyatt Road. Head back North using the bike trail on 7 Highway. Turn right on Lake Village Blvd, aka Liggett Road back to Moreland School Road. Continue West then North through residential neighborhoods, through historic downtown and back to the Pool-Plex. Receive detailed map with registration.

Registration

Pre-registration ends June 1, the cost is \$20 per cyclist. Registration after June 1 will cost \$25 and includes a T-shirt 'while they last' only. CHILDREN UNDER 18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR THEIR DESIGNEE.
