 All dogs must have current rabies and distemper vaccinations.
- 1. Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6' at all times. No retractable leashes are allowed.
- 2. Each walk participant is limited to two dogs. Please encourage family members and friends to register and help you walk your dogs.
- 3. Please be considerate of other trail users. Walk on the right side of the trail with no more than two people across.
- 4. Please be a responsible pet owner and pick up after your dog. Bags will be provided.
- 5. For their safety, any pets other than dogs are not allowed at this event.
- 6. Any people with dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior will be asked to leave.

Water for dogs will be provided in community bowls. Please bring your dog's own water if necessary and bring water for yourself.
