I hereby waive, release and discharge Every Creature Counts, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers and agents, event officials, South Suburban Parks and Recreation District, Denver Water, and any sponsors, suppliers, independent contractors and all other individuals and entities in any way assisting or connected with this event from any and all claims, harm, and liability of whatever kind or nature whatsoever arising out of my participation in this event, even though those claims and liabilities may arise as a result of action or inaction by individuals or entities released by this Waiver and Release. I understand and agree that Every Creature Counts does not insure against and accepts no responsibility for personal injury, property loss or damage which I may sustain. I hereby agree and covenant for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and anyone else who may claim on my behalf, not to sue. A signed registration form is required for each participant.

Paws in the Park Rules:

1. Dogs must be at least 6 months old and spayed or neutered. All dogs must have current rabies and distemper vaccinations.
1. Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6' at all times. No retractable leashes are allowed.
2. Each walk participant is limited to two dogs. Please encourage family members and friends to register and help you walk your dogs.
3. Please be considerate of other trail users. Walk on the right side of the trail with no more than two people across.
4. Please be a responsible pet owner and pick up after your dog. Bags will be provided.
5. For their safety, any pets other than dogs are not allowed at this event.
6. Any people with dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior will be asked to leave.

Water for dogs will be provided in community bowls. Please bring your dog's own water if necessary and bring water for yourself.
