- 3 Senate Bill 482, which created the Texas Holocaust and Genocide
- 4 Commission; the commission is dedicated to obtaining, organizing,
- 5 and distributing information on genocides and to ensuring that
- 6 schools, organizations, and communities have access to this
- 7 genocide information and history; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The legislature has chosen the month of April to
- 9 emphasize the need to heighten public awareness of the early stages
- 10 of human behavior that spawn acts of genocide, the need to build
- 11 strong communities and prevent future genocides, and the need on
- 12 the state and national levels to continue to honor all who have been
