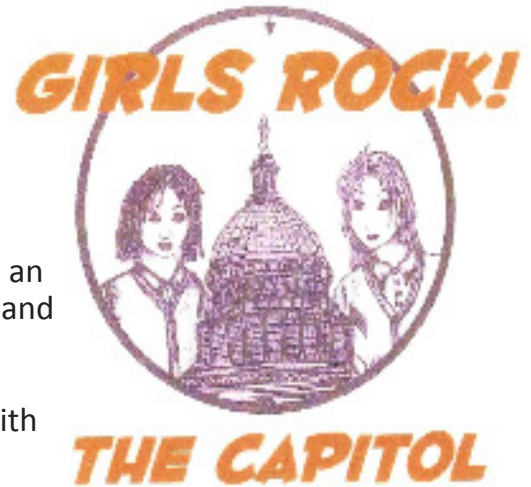

Girls ages 13-18 are invited to Girls Rock! the Capitol. This event is an opportunity for girls to learn about leadership, state government, and how to interact with elected officials. Attendees will participate in workshops, a mock election, and a mock committee hearing. In addition, the girls will have an opportunity to meet and interact with legislators. Special guests this year include Representative Erin Murphy; Minneapolis City Councilwoman Elizabeth Glidden; Guadalupe Lopez, Minnesota Indian Women's Sexual Assault Coalition, and more.

Girls from or affiliated with member organizations of the Women's Consortium will be given priority in registration. General admission for all other groups will open on January 15, 2013. Due to space, organizations and groups that are not members of the Women's Consortium may not be granted admission. In addition, we ask that each group send only five girls. Registration fills up fast, so it is recommended that groups register ASAP. The Women's Consortium requires that all groups have at least one adult escort. In order to make this event accessible to girls from all socio-economic backgrounds, there is no registration fee for this event. However, donations are welcome from individuals and organizations.
