DESIGNS - Calls for Evidence

Request from the UK Intellectual Property Office

Following the Hargreaves Review of Intellectual Property commissioned by Prime Minister David Cameron one of the 10 Recommendations was that Design has an important contribution to make to the UK's growth. The Government has recently issued a 'call for evidence' (1.31Mb) in relation to the design sector and launched a supporting online questionnaire/survey aimed at businesses within the creative industries. ACID will be working closely and positively alongside the UK IPO to ensure that design's voice is heard loudly and clearly with the creation of sound policy and tangible actions to support this important part of the economy.
