New Path Center (NPC) is grateful for the financial support received during 2011. This *Guide to Giving* shares how financial support furthers the scope and ministry of NPC, and helps NPC reach its goals for 2012.

The Ministry of NPC:

As a pastoral-counseling resource, NPC brings the hope of experiencing peace with loss to those who are deeply bereaved.

As a training center, NPC equips individuals, leaders, and organizations to improve communication skills and have a healthy readiness for and response to conflict, and offers court-approved Anger Management classes.

As a mediation center, NPC provides options for ADR (alternative dispute resolution) for those who experience some form of conflict.

Mediation practice includes:

- **Conflict Coaching:** Conflict management strategies and communication skills for individuals
- **Family Mediation:** For family members who have conflict, estrangement or separation, to experience the hope of restoring family relationships
- **Marital Mediation:** For couples who want to stay married but have issues to work through, deeper understanding to share, forgiveness to experience, and agreements to make and keep for a brighter marital future
- **Community Mediations:** Individuals directed by the courts to reconcile offenses and make restitution, including VORP Mediation and Community Justice Conferences
- **Congregation Facilitation:** Churches, cornerstones of any community, can respond to conflict in ways that make hope, love, and peace a reality

The Leadership of NPC:

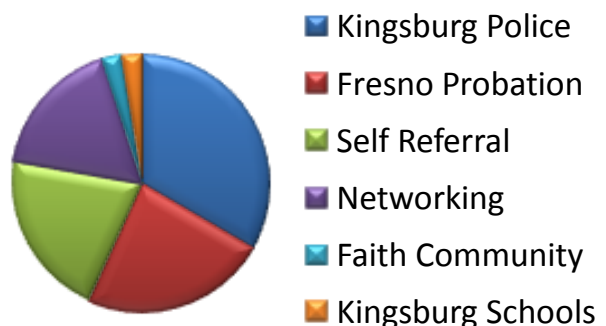
NPC's Board of Directors consists of professionals from the Kingsburg community. The list of Directors is available upon request.

FINAL End-of-Year Scope of NPC:

One way to measure effectiveness is by caseload. During 2011, NPC managed 81 cases (71 new / 10 carried over)

- Mediation, training, and conflict coaching within California and the U.S.

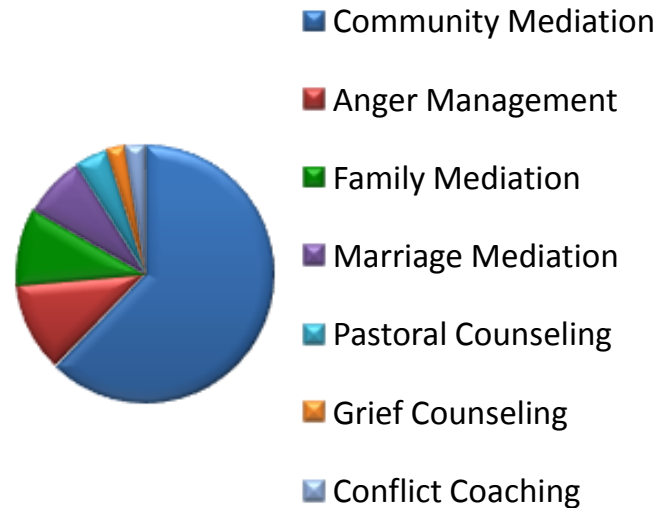
