## 2011 Crafts Marketplace: CALL for ARTISAN VENDORS Saturday & Sunday, October 15 & 16, 2011

The Noyes Museum of Stockton College will once again present our Annual Crafts Marketplace, a two day event showcasing fine art, fine crafts, and other fine handmade goods.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** This year's fair will be indoors and outdoors, *rain or shine*.

If you are interested in outdoor space, please indicate this on your application.

A reduced fee for outdoor space applies; overnight security for outdoor items provided by museum.

### Event Details:

Dates: Saturday & Sunday, October 15 & 16, 2011 (Indoors & Outdoors)

Times: Saturday: 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM & Sunday: 10:00 AM - 4:00 PM

### Additional Information:

- Setup is Friday, 1:00 - 5:00 PM for indoor vendors, and Saturday, 7:30 - 10:00 AM for ALL vendors.
- The Museum provides space only. All tables, chairs, etc. are to be provided by the participating vendor.
- Indoor vendors will be given approximately 6' x 8' of display area. Outdoor vendors receive a 10'x10' space, must provide your own white tent with sides, display walls must be covered.
- Any electrical access must be pre-arranged with Museum staff.
- Accepted vendors must be present on both days of the event.
- Vendors must exercise due caution around all artwork in the Museum. Display must not touch artwork.
- No commercially or mass produced items will be accepted. No imports or items made from kits or commercial patterns will be allowed.
- Photographs taken of vendors work, exhibit, or person may be used by the Museum for publicity purposes.

### To Apply:

- There is no fee to apply. A space fee is due only from accepted participants.
- Artists in a variety of media are encouraged to apply, including the following: paintings, sculpture, prints, photographs, jewelry, ceramics, wood, home décor, clothing and accessories.
- Applicants must complete and submit the attached form by **Friday, July 25th, to the Noyes Museum.**
- **Applications must include 8 images of your original work and 2 images of your current booth layout.**
- Submit color images on CD in jpeg format set to 300 dpi. Each image should be no larger than 3MB.

***Deviations from this procedure will automatically disqualify the applicant.***

### Selection & Notification:

Submissions will be reviewed by the Fine Arts & Crafts Marketplace committee.

Upon notification of acceptance, the vendor must remit payment of their vendor space fee by August 22th.

The fee is \$100.00, for indoor space; \$75 for outdoor space.

### Payment Methods:

Credit card or checks made payable to: *The Noyes Museum of Art* will be accepted.

***Payment will NOT be accepted prior to notification of acceptance by the Museum.***
