We'll have a better estimate of how much to grow at the beginning of the season, and we'll have extra capitol to invest in seeds and infrastructure. How it works:

A chalkboard will be set up with a list of produce and the amounts that you can take to fill your order. After you chose your veggies, you will pay the \$20 fee.
