Your trip includes: travel to and from Carlisle to JFK, roundtrip international airfare and domestic airfare, 4 and 5 star hotel accommodations, meals, deluxe buses with English speaking tour guides, and entrance fees for attractions.

Nov. 1 JFK/Bangkok – Bus to JFK for a mid-morning flight. Cross the International Date Line.

Nov. 2 Bangkok – Arrive in Hong Kong and take a connecting flight to Bangkok. Transfer to the hotel for a rest before touring the city in the afternoon.

Nov. 3 Bangkok /Pattaya –Visit the Golden Palace, Emerald Buddha, and Art of Kingdom Exhibition at Anata Samakhom Throne Hall. After lunch visit the Leather Shop and then board a bus to Pattaya. Enjoy a seafood BBQ buffet for dinner.

Nov. 4 Pattaya – Take the morning to relax and enjoy the beautiful, clean beaches at Coral Island. After lunch visit the botanical gardens of Nong Nooch. Ride an elephant and visit the Pattaya Four Regions Floating market to learn how the Thai people live in each of the regions. Stop at the World Gems Factory.

Nov. 5 Pattaya/Bangkok – In the morning drive back to Bangkok and stop at local produce and market stalls. Lunch is a Royal Suki set menu. In the afternoon visit Four Face Buddha in Bangkok. Dinner is a Ramayana buffet and show.

Nov. 6 Bangkok/Ayutthaya/Bangkok – Drive to Ayutthaya, built in 1350 and at one time the capital of Siam. Stop at the Summer Palace Pang Pa Inn. Siam Niramit Buffet & Show in the evening.

Nov. 7 Bangkok/Hong Kong – Late morning flight to Hong Kong which is known as the "east pearl." Cross over the Tsing Ma Bridge, the longest suspension bridge which has lanes for both cars and trains. Stop by the Avenue of Art which honors outstanding professionals of Hong Kong's film industry. Ride the Peak Tram to the top of Peak where you have a view of the city and Victoria Harbor.

Nov. 8 Hong Kong – Visit Ngong Ping 360, consisting of a cable car journey and a themed village, Repulse Bay with its clean and well tended beaches, and Stanley, a former fishing village which was one of the largest towns on the island before the British arrived. Visit the Hong Kong Jewelry Store. Lunch is on own as you have the afternoon free. Enjoy a Roasted Goose dinner in the evening.

Nov. 9 Hong Kong/JFK – After breakfast transfer to the airport for an afternoon flight to JFK. Arrive at JFK the same day. Return to Carlisle by bus.
