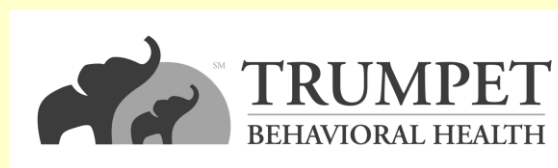

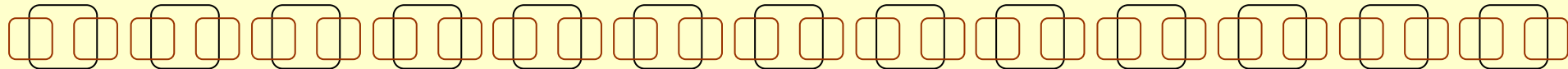

## Workshop Descriptions:

### Title: Teaching Independent Skills at Home

Presenter: Kristen Rittenhouse-Shaw, BCaBA

This workshop will focus on promoting independence and appropriate, productive engagement at home. We will discuss how to choose appropriate activities to target, teach those activities, utilize activity schedules, and provide reinforcement.

### Title: Toilet Training Strategies

Presenter: Hal Houseworth, M.Ed.

This presentation will focus on the most effective research methods and varying options for toilet training.

### Title: ABCs of ABA

Presenter: LaTosha Lafferty, BCBA

This presentation will focus on analyzing and responding to problem behaviors. Although specific behavior plans will not be discussed, we will be providing information on how to identify target behaviors, take data, analyze data, identify functions of behavior, and create a plan.

### Title: Waivers in Ohio

Presenter: Judy LaMusga, JD

This presentation will consist of a discussion regarding the various waivers available to individuals with disabilities. Medicaid Home and Community-Based (HCBS) waivers provide alternatives to institutional long-term care through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services' (ODJFS) Medicaid office. The term "waiver" refers to an exception to federal law that is granted to a state by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Waivers allow participants, who have disabilities and chronic conditions, to have more control of their lives and remain active participants in their community.

### Title: Special Needs Trusts

Presenter: Chuck Locy, Financial Consultant

This presentation will focus on the details of special needs trusts. People with Development Disabilities, or an adult onset disability, need all the proper financial and legal assistance to protect their assets and enhance their quality of life. A special needs trust is created to ensure that beneficiaries who are disabled or mentally ill can enjoy the use of property which is intended to be held for their benefit.

### Title: Teaching in the Natural Environment

Presenter: Lisa Flake-Houseworth, JD, BCBA

This workshop is designed to help parents, educators, and other practitioners learn how to teach a child with autism or other developmental disabilities effectively in the natural environment. An overview of B.F. Skinner's analysis of language will be given to explain the different types of expressive language skills (verbal operants) that a child needs to acquire. In addition, participants will be encouraged to complete and share a NET (natural environment teaching) lesson plan.

### Title: Tips for Working Collaboratively with Schools

Presenter: Lisa Flake-Houseworth, JD, BCBA

This presentation will focus on practical strategies and tips for working with schools collaboratively while advocating for appropriate, data-driven behavioral services. A review of the Individual Education Program (IEP) process and parental rights will be discussed. In addition, this presentation will review practical tips for working with schools collaboratively and also a brief review of what courts are saying about ABA services.

### Title: Effective Data Collection

Presenter: Hal Houseworth, M.Ed.

This presentation will focus on data collection, from choosing what type of data will produce useful information for how to take data efficiently and effectively.
