

THREE'S AND FOUR'S BABY QUILT

MATERIALS

Skill Level - Beginner

Finished Size = 34" x 35"

- .8m assorted cotton prints or 28-8" squares for triangles
- .6m white cotton for sashing and outer borders
- .25m coordinating fabric for binding
- 40" square batting
- 40" square flannel for backing

*all seams are 1/4"

WOF = Width of Fabric

Triangles are fun, and this quilt will catch the eye and attention of any baby with its bright colours and cheery prints. Want to make it larger? It's simple - just add more triangles and more rows!



FABRIC PREPARATION

From white cotton fabric, cut:

- 3 - 2" x 28" sashing
- 2 - 3½" x 28" top & bottom borders
- 2 - 3½" x 35" side borders

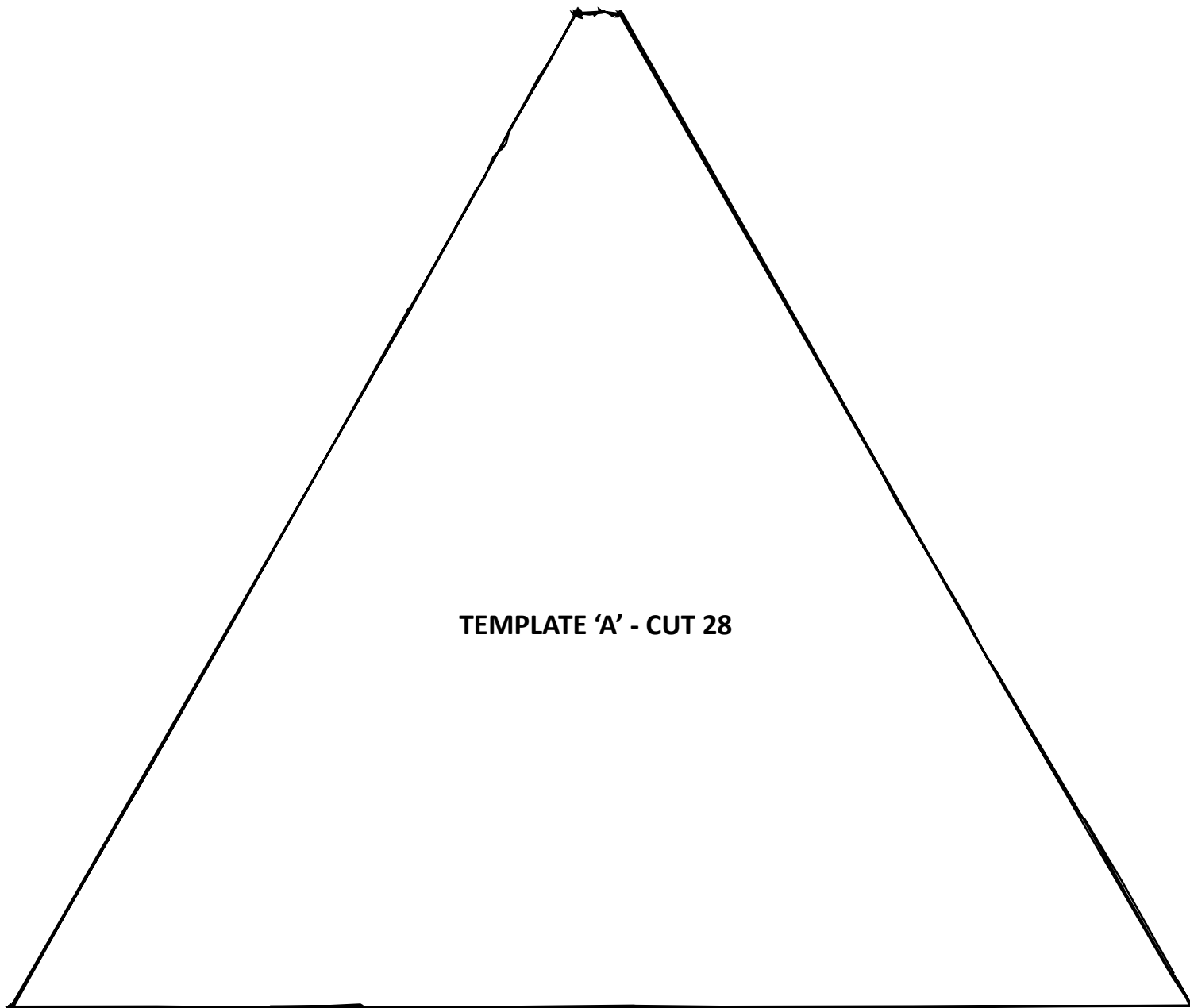
ASSEMBLY

1. Using Template A, cut 28 triangles from assorted cotton prints. Using Template B, cut 4 half-triangles, and 4 half-triangles reversed.
3. Sew 7 triangles together, and 1 half-triangle to each end, as shown in sample. Press seams to one side. Make 4 sets.
4. Sew the 4 triangle strip sets together, with a 2" sashing strip in between each row. Press seams towards light fabric.
5. Sew top and bottom outer borders on, pressing seams towards border fabric. Sew side outer borders on, pressing seams towards border fabric.

FINISHING

1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Sample quilt was completed using straight-line shadow stitching 1/4" from seams.
2. Bind quilt using your favourite binding method.
