Reluctantly, Tia agreed to view an ultrasound, and when it revealed that the baby was too small to be seen, Tia agreed to return for a second scan.

Today, as I write this story, Tia has returned to Rachel House. She is still frantic, and our staff is concerned and burdened about the path this woman will take. All Tia knows is Rachel House. She knows she is accepted and has experienced love, compassion, and prayers that have been offered to her. We believe that the Lord, who she doesn't know, is working on her behalf and for the life of her child. Together we will stand in the gap for Tia and her baby. Are you standing with us?
