Interpretive and Recreational Hiking with Ranger Robby Every Friday and Sunday - 8:00 a.m.

Explore the Preserve's trails to learn about natural, cultural, and historical resources. Hikes are moderate for 2-3 hours. Please bring your own water. Specific programs are listed below:

Habitat Hikes - Explore the diversity of the Preserve's habitats as we trek through forest, outcrops, fields, and wetlands.
