



Mighty Cash Cats to perform at Railroad Days

SAN BERNARDINO - The Mighty Cash Cats are one of the featured attractions at the annual Railroad Days festival happening here on Saturday and Sunday.

The weekend event, with steam train rides, exhibits and demonstrations, costumed re-enactors, merchandise and memorabilia vendors, live entertainment, food and more, takes place at the San Bernardino History and Railroad Museum inside the historic Santa Fe Depot.

Festival and museum admission are free both days.

Guitarist and vocalist Michael Jay Smith of the Mighty Cash Cats pays tribute to Johnny Cash during the band's show covering songs ranging from 1955's "Folsom Prison Blues" to 2003's "Hurt," Cash's hit cover of the 1994 Nine Inch Nails song.
