

Digital Data Base Tracking of Teacher Observations – This a half-day workshop (NO ISBE ACADEMY CREDIT) teaching the administrator how to use an iPad to record the evidence for informal and formal teacher observations, sort the evidence for later rating use, use video for recording purposes and prepare summary observational documents for the formal teacher observation process. The user will watch videos of teachers teaching a lesson, use a digital database-gathering instrument to record teacher observation evidence, categorize the evidence and rate the Domain/Component according to the Danielson Frameworks for Teaching. The database allows the evaluator to organize all of the evidence statements for rating purposes. Participants must bring a laptop computer or other digital device such as an iPad.

Cost: For districts that want to bring this training to their own district and include their own administrators the cost is \$750. Smaller districts can offer a joint training and the cost would be \$100 per participant.
