The programme will take us right up to The Knitting &Stitching Show at Ally Pally (just doesn't seem right to be talking about that already!) and is heaving with workshops. There's several new tutors with completely new workshops, but the tutors we know and love are still very definitely making an appearance. Look out for Jonathan Korejko, a passionate papermaker; Alice Fox doing beautiful delicate things with rust; Julia Triston using lace as inspiration; Clive Barnett with screen-printing and Wendy Creak using your handwriting as a design source.

We have just recently welcomed Beth - a Textiles graduate - to work alongside Ann (still at the helm and completely invaluable), Janys, Liz, Shelagh and Stuart, so all is well!



Real gelatine plates are fantastic but they're a fag to make, and you have to plan ahead. **Gelli Plates** give you very nearly all the characteristics of a gelatine plate (you can get really detailed consistent prints very easily using very little ink or paint) but without the mess, and they're there ready to use


