



## Loyal 10 Ply

### CABLE GAUNTLETS

Photographed in: Loyal 10ply #921

To fit approx: 8-10 (12-14) years

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Total length approx 18 (21)cm/  
7 (8 ¼)ins

### MATERIALS

2 (2) balls **Loyal Aran/10ply** 100% Wool (50gr/1.75oz;  
approx 84m/92yds) in shade #921

4mm & 4.5mm (US 6 & 7) needles

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Cable needle

2 stitch marker

### TENSION

20 sts and 26 rows over Stst on 4.5mm (US 7) needles -  
10cm/4ins

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

**C6B** - slip 3 sts to cn and hold at back of work k3, k3 from cn.

**C6F** - slip 3 sts to cn and hold at front of work k3, k3 from cn.

### LEFT GAUNTLET

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 43 (47) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1; \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** - P1; \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 3 (4) times more.

Change to 4.5mm (US 7) needles.

#### Beg Cable Panel

**Row 1 (RS)** - P3 (5), place marker (pm), p3, k6, p1, k6,  
p3, pm; p21 (23).

**Row 2 and all other WS rows** - K the knit sts and p the  
purl sts and yo's (work sts as they face you).

**Row 3 (RS)** - P3 (5); p3, C6B, p1, C6F, p3; p21 (23).

**Row 5** - P3 (5); p2, k2tog, k5, yo, p1, yo, k5, skp, p2; p21  
(23).

**Row 7** - P3 (5); p1, k2tog, k5, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k5, skp,  
p1; p21 (23).

**Row 9** - P3 (5); k2tog, k5, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k5, skp; p21  
(23).

**Row 10** - K the knit sts and p the purl sts and yo's (work  
sts as they face you).

Rep these 10 rows 3 (4) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

K1, p1 rib for 8 (10) rows.

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

### RIGHT GAUNTLET

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 43 (47) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1; \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2** - P1; \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 3 (4) times more.

Change to 4.5mm (US 7) needles.

#### Beg Cable Panel

**Row 1 (RS)** - P21 (23), place marker (pm), p3, k6, p1, k6,  
p3, pm; p3 (5).

**Row 2 and all other WS rows** - K the knit sts and p the  
purl sts and yo's (work sts as they face you).

**Row 3 (RS)** - P21 (23); p3, C6B, p1, C6F, p3; p3 (5).

**Row 5** - P21 (23); p2, k2tog, k5, yo, p1, yo, k5, skp, p2;  
p3 (5).

**Row 7** - P21 (23); p1, k2tog, k5, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, k5,  
skp, p1; p3 (5).

**Row 9** - P21 (23); k2tog, k5, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, k5, skp;  
p3 (5).

**Row 10** - K the knit sts and p the purl sts and yo's (work  
sts as they face you).

Rep these 10 rows 3 (4) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

K1, p1 rib for 8 (10) rows.

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

### COMPLETE

Join the last worked 8 (10) rows of rib.

Skip next 3 (3.5)cm/ 1 ¼ (1 ½)ins for thumb opening, then  
sew remaining seam.

# Loyal Aran/10ply

For best results use ONLY the yarn specified.

All yarn amounts are based on average requirements and should therefore be regarded as approximate.

## SPECIAL TERMS:

**k1- tbl** - knit 1 stitch through back loop

**M1** - pick up running thread from front to back, k it through the back loop;

**skp** – slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch, pass the slipped st over (= left slanting decrease)

**ssk** - slip next 2 sts knitwise, one at a time to right hand needle, then insert tip of left hand needle into fronts of these stitches from left to right and knit them together to decrease 1 stitch;
