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ABBREVIATIONS

Beg - beginning; cm - centimetres; cont - continue; dec - decrease; inc increase; inc - increase; ins - inches; k - knit; meas - measures; NR - next row; patt - pattern; rem - remaining; rep - repeat; RSF - right side facing; st(s) - stitch(es); Stst - Stocking stitch (K on RS rows/P on WS rows); tog together; WS – wrong side.

IMPORTANT

Use ONLY the Naturally yarn specified.

(We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.) Follow our instructions exactly. We advise every knitter to check their tension carefully before commencing the garment.

All measurements in this design are based on the stated tension therefore it is essential that the correct tension be obtained and maintained throughout

the garment to achieve success. We recommend the needle size we have used to obtain the tension BUT as each knitter knits differently it may be necessary for some knitters to change their needle size accordingly.

8ply

TENSION

8ply: 22 sts and 30 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 3.75mm (US 5) needles.

PANEL PATTERN

(over 18 sts)

Row 1 (RS) - K11, p1, k6.

Row 2 - P7, k1, p10.

Row 3 - K9, p1, k1, p1, k6.

Row 4 - P7, k1, p1, k1, p8. Row 5 - K7, [p1, k1] twice, p1, k6.

Row 6 - P7, [k1, p1] 5 times, k1.

Row 7 - [K1, p1] 6 times, k6.

Row 8 - P5, [k1, p1] 5 times, k1. p2.

Row 9 - K3, [p1, k1] 5 times, p1, k4.

Row 10 - P3, [k1, p1] 5 times, k1, p4.

Row 11 - K5, [p1, k1] 5 times, p1, k2.

Row 12 - [P1, k1] 6 times, p6.

Row 13 - K7, [p1, k1] 5 times, p1.

Row 14 - P7, [k1, p1] twice, k1, p6.

Row 15 - K7, p1, k1, p1, k8.

Row 16 - P9, k1, p1, k1, p6.

Row 17 - K7, p1, k10.

Row 18 – P11, k1, p6.

Row 19 - K all sts.

Row 20 - P all sts.

Rep these 20 rows for panel patt throughout.

BACK

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles, cast on 65 (73, 77, 81) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 3.5 (3.5, 4, 4) cm, end with a WS row and inc 1 st in last row to 66 (74, 78, 82) sts.

Change to 3.75mm (US 5) needles. Stst 2 rows.

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Beg Panel patt

NR (RS) – K24 (28, 30, 32) sts, work row 1 of Panel patt over next 18 sts, k rem 24 (28, 30, 32) sts.

Cont in this manner working panel patt over centre 18 sts, work until piece meas 31 (34, 38, 43) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K25 (28, 30, 31) sts, turn, on these sts only.

NR (WS) - Cast off 3 sts, p to end. K 1 row.

NR - Cast off 3 sts, p to end.

Cast off rem 19 (22, 24, 25) sts.

Return to sts on hold, slip next 16 (18, 18, 20) sts to holder for centre back neck, rejoin yarn, work 2nd half to match, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as for back until front meas 28 (30, 34, 39) cm, end with a WS row. Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K25 (29, 31, 33) sts, turn, on these sts only.

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 6 (7, 7, 8) rows.

Cont straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a WS row. Cast off rem 19 (22, 24, 25) sts.

Return to sts on hold, slip next 16 sts to holder for centre front neck, rejoin yarn, work 2nd half to match, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles, cast on 38 (40, 44, 46) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 3 (3, 3.5, 3.5) cm, end with a WS row.

Change to 3.75mm (US 5) needles. Stst 6 rows and inc 1 st each end of 5th row - 40 (42, 46, 48) sts.

Beg Panel patt

(There will be only one rep of 20 rows to be worked)

NR (RS) – K11 (12, 14, 15) sts, work row 1 of Panel patt over next 18 sts, k rem 11 (12, 14, 15) sts.

Cont in this manner working panel patt to end of row 20 over centre 18 sts, AT SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end every 6th (6th, 5th, 5th) row.

When 20 rows of panel patt have been completed, cont in Stst over all sts, keeping inc's correct as established to 56 (60, 70, 78) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 24 (27, 30, 34) cm from beg, end with a WS row. Cast off **loosely.**

COMPLETE

Use mattress st to sew all seams. Join shoulder seams.

NECKBAND

With RSF and 3.25mm (US 3) needles, pick up and k7 sts down back neck, k the back neck holder sts, pick up and k7 sts up back neck, 14 (14, 16, 16) sts down left front neck, k the front neck holder sts, pick up and k 14 (14, 16, 16) sts up right front neck - 74 (76, 80, 82) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 7 rows.

Cast off very loosely in rib.

Place markers 14 (15, 17, 18) cm down from shoulders on back and front. Insert sleeve tops between markers. Join side and sleeve seams.

Lightly press seams on wrong side.

10ply

TENSION

10ply: 20 sts and 26 rows over Stst - 10cm (4ins) on 4.5mm (US 7) needles

BACK

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 61 (65, 73, 77) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 3.5 (3.5, 4, 4) cm, end with a WS row and inc 1 st in last row to 62 (66, 74, 78) sts.

Change to 4.5mm (US 7) needles. Stst 2 rows.

Beg Panel patt

NR (RS) – K22 (24, 28, 30) sts, work row 1 of Panel patt over next 18 sts, k rem 22 (24, 28, 30) sts.

Cont in this manner working panel patt over centre 18 sts, work until piece meas 31 (34, 38, 43) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K24 (25, 29, 30) sts, turn, on these sts only.

NR (WS) - Cast off 3 sts, p to end. K 1 row.

NR - Cast off 3 sts, p to end.

Cast off rem 18 (19, 23, 24) sts.

Return to sts on hold, slip next 14 (16, 16, 18) sts to holder for centre back neck, rejoin yarn, work 2nd half to match, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as for back until front meas 28 (30, 34, 39) cm, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K24 (25, 29, 31) sts, turn, on these sts only.

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 6 (6, 6, 7) rows.

Cont straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a WS row. Cast off rem 18 (19, 23, 24) sts.

Return to sts on hold, slip next 14 (16, 16, 16) sts to holder for centre front neck, rejoin yarn, work 2nd half to match, reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 36 (38, 40, 42) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 3 (3, 3.5, 3.5) cm, end with a WS row.

Change to 4.5mm (US 7) needles.

Stst 6 rows and inc 1 st each end of 5^{th} row -38 (40, 42, 44) sts.

Beg Panel patt

(There will be only one rep of 20 rows to be worked)

NR (RS) – K10 (11, 12, 13) sts, work row 1 of Panel patt over next 18 sts, k rem 10 (11, 12, 13) sts.

Cont in this manner working panel patt to end of row 20 over centre 18 sts, AT SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end every 6th (6th, 5th, 5th) row.

When 20 rows of panel patt have been completed, cont in Stst over all sts, keeping inc's correct as established to 52 (56, 64, 72) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 24 (27, 30, 34) cm from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off loosely.

COMPLETE

Use mattress st to sew all seams. Join shoulder seams.

NECKBAND

With RSF and 4mm (US 6) needles, pick up and k7 sts down back neck, k the back neck holder sts, pick up and k7 sts up back neck, 13 (13, 15, 15) sts down left front neck, k the front neck holder sts, pick up and k13 (13, 15, 15) sts up right front neck - 68 (72, 76, 78) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 7 rows.

Cast off very loosely in rib.

Place markers 14 (15, 17, 18) cm down from shoulders on back and front. Insert sleeve tops between markers. Join side and sleeve seams.

Lightly press seams on wrong side.





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
