IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PROJECT REACH ASSISTANCE:

- You must not have received energy assistance in the previous 12 months
- You must be a permanent residential customer of NV Energy who is at least 62 years of age or older
- Your NV Energy bill must be in your name and you must live at the address for which assistance is requested
- The maximum Project REACH award at this event is your past due balance up to \$350
- The maximum annual gross income of your household must be within the guidelines below:

DOCUMENTS TO BRING TO THE EVENT:

- Nevada driver license or Nevada State ID
- Your past due NV Energy electric bill in need of payment (the address on your ID must match the address on your electric bill)
- Proof of income or pending income. "Cash Only" applicants must provide one of the following:
 - Letter from the employer on company letterhead
 - Current bank statement showing recent deposit activity
 - Current income tax records

IMPORTANT CONDITIONS:

- If you receive energy assistance and have an unpaid balance remaining, you **must** make payment arrangements for the balance at the event
- The energy assistance awarded at this event cannot be used to pay on closed accounts or transferred accounts, deposits, returned check fees and charges, meter damage charges, fraudulent usage fees, final bills or to restore service if it has been terminated due to non-payment or because of a default in payment arrangements

- If you have received energy assistance in the previous 12 months you are not eligible to receive Project REACH assistance at this event
- American Sign Language interpreters on site
- Free wheelchair-accessible parking lot shuttle service is provided
