
Bio - Dr. Leslie Kiraly

Dr. Kiraly is a lecturer at the University of Toronto. He graduated in medicine in 1974 and psychiatry in 1979 from the University of Toronto. He has held a staff position at the Toronto East General Hospital since 1979. He helped develop aftercare, day treatment, housing programs, and served as the Director of outpatients in the 1980's. He was the Chief of Psychiatry at the Peel Memorial Hospital (William Osler Health Centre) from 1990 to 2001. He worked on the Mood Disorder Clinic at the Centre for Addiction and Mental Health between 2001 and 2010. He holds a staff position at the Collingwood General and Marine Hospital since 1985.

He helped to develop the community mental health clinic and continues to do clinical work in this underdeveloped community. He consults for WSIB and insurance companies. About half of his time is spent working with Insurance industries. He is an active member of the Canadian Society of Medical Evaluators.

He has developed private mental health clinics in East Toronto and Brampton with the help of GP/Psychotherapist to assist family physicians to have access to mental health services and education.

He holds licence to practice medicine in Ontario and the state of Ohio and Texas in the US. He is the President of the Ontario District Branch of the American Psychiatry Association.
